Decertification Process
of Al-Anon Members Involved in Alateen Service (AMIAS)

(approved by Area World Service Committee January 15, 2011)

1. Upon receipt of information to the Area World Service Committee (AWSC) and/or Area Chairperson that an AMIAS has failed to adhere to the North Carolina Alateen Safety and Behavioral Requirements, the Area Chair will notify the elected officers of the AWSC, which are the World Service Delegate, Alternate Delegate, Area Treasurer and Area Secretary, that such an incident has occurred.
2. After notifying the elected officers of the AWSC, the Area Chairperson will notify the AMIAS in writing that their Certification is being revoked and the reason. A notice of the immediate revocation will also be sent in writing to the sponsoring Al-Anon Group and the District Representative.
3. If the AWSC is notified that a concern has arisen with an AMIAS, the AWSC acting through the Area Chair (and including another Area officer), may initiate an investigation by interviewing witnesses and any involved persons. A summary of such interviews and any action taken will be reported back to the AWSC for consensus and/or further necessary action.
4. If an AMIAS certification has been revoked, the member may be considered again for certification if he/she (1) meets the Area Requirements, (2) completes the required training, and (3) submits a new application for certification.
